TERM 2

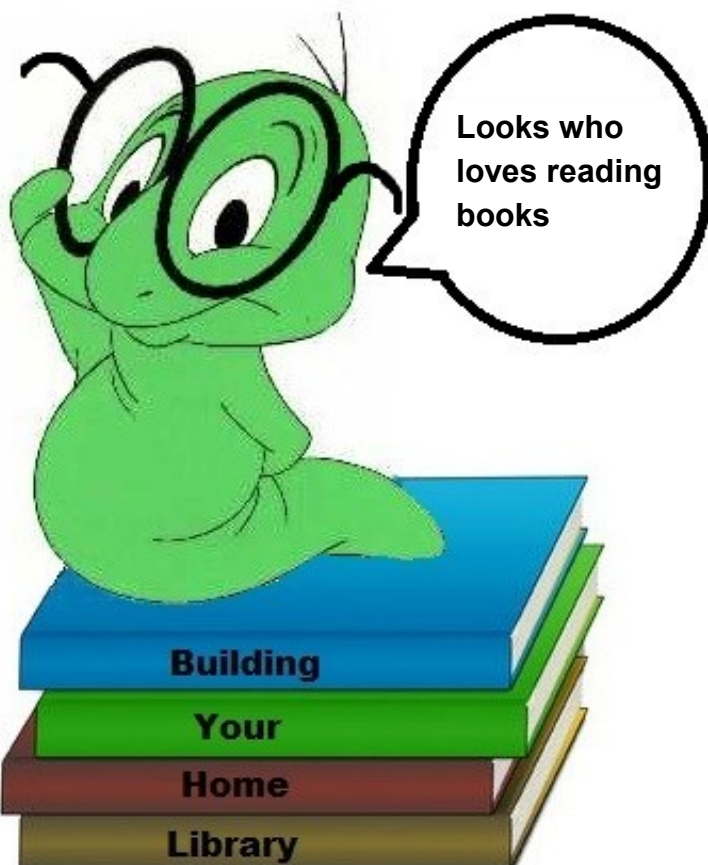

Our school has a commitment to supporting our student's academically, socially and emotionally. We are proud to be a KidsMatter school and as part of this initiative all classes will be teaching the Bounce Back program. This term each class is focusing on no bullying.

Year 3 and 4 will focus on the understanding that bullying spoils things for

everyone, it makes people feel unsafe and worried. If you see someone being a bully you must act and report it to an adult. Never join in! Sometimes people join in with bullying to fit in or to avoid being bullied themselves. Don't be a sheep, if you choose to do this there is no one else to blame but yourself and you will also face the same consequences. Why do people bully? It is never the victims fault, no one deserves to be bullied but often there is reason behind the bully's behaviour. They may they may be acting out, they may not realise that they are being a bully and sometimes they are being bullied themselves. It's important to be able to recognise bullying and report it and also have the skills and understanding to know what to do if you are being bullied!

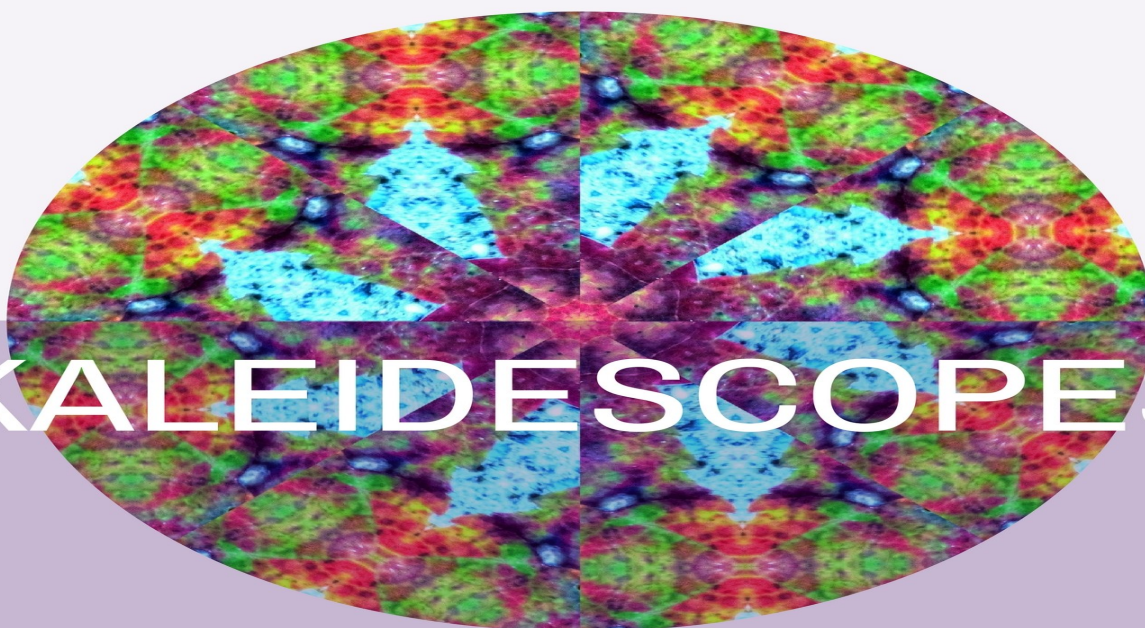
