Well done to all, and again, thanks to our parents and carers for all their support.





Attendance Matters

At Sanctuary Point Public School



for any day your child is absent.

There are a few ways you can do this..

◆ A written note to the class teacher

Stating:

- Your child's full name,
- The date they were away
- The reason they were not at school
- Your signature and the date

◆ Using the Skoolbag App

- Using your smartphone open the App and click 'eForms'
- Choose 'Absentee Form' and fill in your child's details.

◆ Phone the school if your child is not at school for 2 days in a row.

- A written note should still be sent to school with your child, along with a Dr. Certificate where appropriate.

Celebrate Attendance

Hints and Tips No 1: Responsibilities



Parent/s or caregivers are required – by law – to provide a written or verbal explanation to the Principal within seven days of any absence as to why their child was not at school.

It is important that the school receives a written or verbal explanation because:

- (1) It is a parent's legal obligation to explain their child's absence within seven days
- (2) It is a requirement that the school investigate all unexplained absences
- (3) It avoids the school and the School Attendance Officer from making unnecessary investigations
- (4) It is the way the school knows that your child was legitimately absent and not truanting from school

If you have any difficulties in providing a written explanation for your child's absence, please contact your school principal.



Missing school leaves gaps in your education

Any absence that is not due to illness, or leave approved by the principal will normally be marked as 'unjustified'.

Students who have less than 90% attendance will be contacted by school to discuss how to improve your child's attendance.
