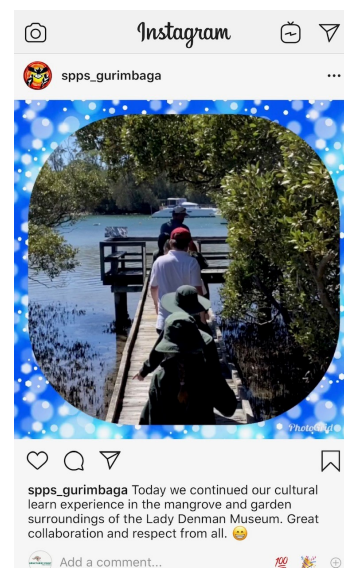

- Entry is open to individual Aboriginal artists residing, working or studying in the Shoalhaven.
- There will be a 10% commission charged on the sale of Artworks entered into the awards.
- Artist payments will be made in the week following the end of exhibition.
- If artworks are deemed culturally inappropriate by the BCA committee; the committee have the right to remove this work from the exhibition.
- Artists may submit more than one artwork. (A separate entry form will need to be attached to each individual Art work at \$5 per entry)
- All artwork must be picked up from Nowra TAFE on Monday 9th December.
- Judges decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Works created in all mediums will be considered for the Awards.
- All artworks will remain on display until Friday 6th December.
- All care will be taken by the BCA committee to ensure the safety and protection of entered artworks. However it is the artist's responsibility to insure their work against accidental damage.
- All entries considered for the Awards must have been completed within the last 12 months
