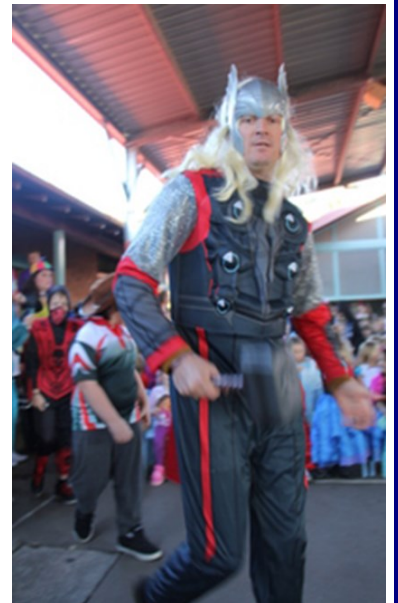

Thanks again and goodbye.



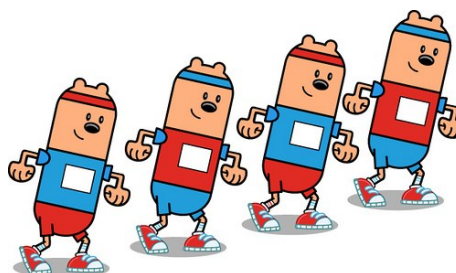

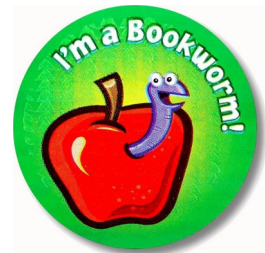
Southern Stars Team.
