STUDENTS RETURN TO SCHOOL

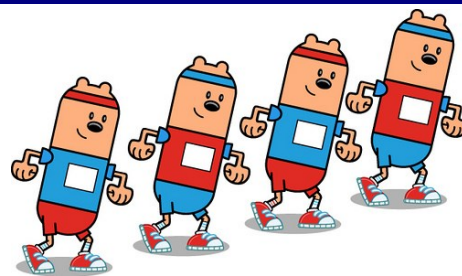

Sanctuary Point Public School Art Attack 2019







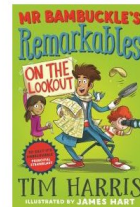
