Choir Performance

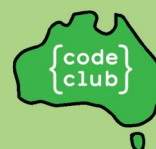

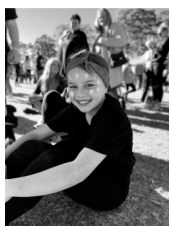
