opportunity for our students.***

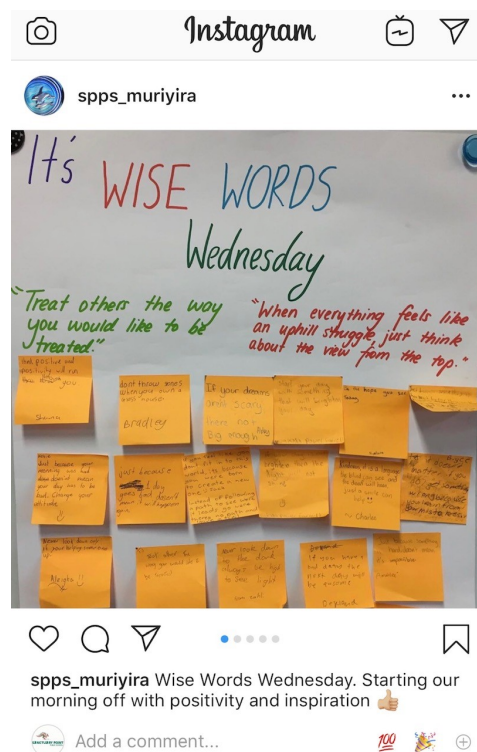
